COMPETITION

- To be eligible for a 2024-25 competition team, dancers must attend bootcamp.
 - Level 1 dancers are required to participate in 6 hours of bootcamp
 - Level 2 and Level 3 dancers must attend 12 hours.
- Dancers are required to participate in auditions and attend a minimum of 4 hours.
- In addition, dancers are required to register for either one competition technique session or one tumbling session, along with one master class.
