

Recital Time and Location information:

- Recital Date: Saturday, February 3rd, 2024
- Venue: Pine City High School, located at 1400 Main St S, Pine City, MN 55063
- Show 1 details:
 - Start time: 11:00am
 - End time: Approximately 12:00pm
- Show 2 details:
 - Start time: 1:00pm
 - End time: Approximately 3:30pm
- Please note the arrival times for each show:
 - For the first show, participants involved in both the recreational and competition classes should arrive at 10:00am. Please note: Recreational dancers will need arrive earlier for the rehearsal. See rehearsal document for more details.
 - For the second show, participants involved in competition should arrive at 12:00pm.

Why we do a Recital?

Participating in a recital offers our students an exciting and empowering opportunity to showcase their hard work and skills. It is a valuable part of their training process, allowing them to learn about the theater, rehearsals, and teamwork. We believe in creating a supportive and fun environment where all students, regardless of age or experience, can perform for their family and friends.

Makeup and Costumes

To ensure our dancers' faces are visible on stage under the bright lights, we kindly request that they wear makeup for recitals. Makeup enhances their expressions and prevents their faces from being washed out. While makeup is not mandatory for our mini recreational dancers, we recommend using foundation, blush, brown eyeshadow, mascara (if permitted), and red lipstick. For all other recreational groups, makeup is required, including the use of fake eyelashes. Makeup for boys is not required but recommended.

Regarding costumes, recreational dancers should wear the recital t-shirt and black leggings, along with the appropriate dance group shoes as specified in the fall information guide. For girls, hair should be pulled back in a half-up, half-down ponytail. Competition dancers should refer to the costume requirements document, which will be sent out in the next month, for specific instructions on hair, makeup, and costumes.

Recital information:

- Recreational dancers will only perform at the 11:00am show.
- It is required that hair and makeup be completed upon arrival at the recital.
- Families with unpaid balances on the day of the recital will not be allowed to participate.
- If your dancer will not be able to attend the dress rehearsal and/or recital, please inform us as soon as possible so that the routines can be adjusted accordingly.
- Standing on the sides of the aisles will not be permitted. This is to avoid distractions for those watching the showcase. Please find your seat and refrain from standing in the aisles.
- During a routine, please refrain from getting up. If you need to leave the auditorium, kindly do so between songs.

Recital Procedure

- Enter through the front entrance and check your dancer in at the designated table. Our staff will then direct you to the dressing room.
- Dancers will remain in the dressing room (band room) until the recital is over and are not permitted to enter the auditorium to watch during the recital.
- Once the show is over, you may return to the dressing room to pick up your dancer.
- Please ensure that you clean up after your dancer when leaving the venue.
- Flash photography is not allowed. Pictures are permitted without flash.
- Explicit language, inappropriate attire, offensive clothing, and criminal behavior will not be tolerated. Consumption of alcohol and smoking are strictly prohibited.
- Males are not allowed in the dressing room as dancers will be changing throughout the recital.
- Running is not permitted in the band room.

Backstage rules

- Those with quick changes are allowed to use the quick-change room as a changing area. Please refer to the "Allowed to Change in Quick Change Room" section for more details.
- Boys will utilize the quick-change room for changing purposes and will wait in the hallway between routines.
- Only Diamond Dance Studio staff and registered parent helpers are permitted backstage.

- We are unable to deliver messages or food to students' backstage, so please ensure they have everything they need before they come backstage during the recital/concert.

Please note: The quick-change room is small space specifically designated for changing purposes only. After changing, dancers will need to return to the band room for the remainder of the recital. Rest assured that an adult will be present in the quick-change room to ensure privacy for the dancers while they change.

 - No nuts or nut products due to allergies.
